While securing an LZ observed and engaged, with small arms fire, 1 NVA with an AK-47 and a pack, approximately 10m from their location. Results were 1 NVA KIA. Captured 1 AK-47, 30 rounds of AK-47 ammo, 1 NVA pith helmet, 1 toilet kit, 1 poncho, 1 notebook, pictures and insignia of 1 star on red background with 1 gold stripe. Will be extracted to LZ Center tomorrow.</p>	BT193113
7	<p>196th Bde, SP Jones C/3-21, at 0510 hrs, in the vicinity of BT193113, while in the night defensive position, heard movement 15m from their perimeter. Engaged with small arms fire. Swept area and found only footprints.</p> <p>196th Bde, PFC Foor, C/3-21, at 0915 hrs, in the vicinity of BT198117, on patrol looking for weapons cache, 1 US accidentally placed his hand in a bear trap, 8" in diameter. Dust off completed at 0940 hrs to LZ Center resulting in 1 US WIA (E).</p> <p>196th Bde, PFC Foor, C/3-21, at 0900 hrs, in the vicinity of BT195125, on patrol checking a structure area, 1 NVA without a weapon and wearing a green uniform approached them from the South. Engaged with small arms fire resulting in 1 NVA KIA. Captured 1 pack, 1 Chicom hand grenade, 1 NVA belt, 1 NVA first aid pouch, 2 NVA pith helmets, 1 US pistol belt, 2 US ammo pouches, 2 US canteens, 1 US canteen</p>	BT194114

	<p>cover, 1 M-60 ammo box containing tools and 1 NVA resupply note signed by the Commander of the NVA unit.</p> <p>196th Bde, C/3-21, at 1300 hrs, in the vicinity of BT194115, found 4 tunnels entrances, 5-15' long. Also found 1 30cal with bipod, 4 rounds of 57cal ammo, 135 rounds of 51cal ammo, 200 rounds of 30cal ammo and 2 NVA green shirts.</p>	
8	<p>196th Bde, PFC Foor, C/3-21, at 1035 hrs, in the vicinity of BT198104, found an enemy base camp. Observed and engaged 1 VC and 1 NVA with small arms fire, approximately 50m East of their location. Results were 1 VC KIA, 1 NVA KIA. Bodies were searched finding 1 NVA pistol belt, 1 pack with medical supplies and 1 medical resupply list, extracted to LZ Young. No unit ID. Artillery being fired.</p> <p>196th Bde, PFC Foor, C/3-21, at 1015 hrs, in the vicinity of BT195118, while on S&C found 1 structure with 1 military aged male, who evaded Northwest, and 1 VN male (65 yrs old). VN male was questioned by KCS. He said many VC were in the area with weapons. VC left when they heard helicopters. VN male was extracted to LZ Young.</p> <p>196th Bde, SP Jones, C/3-21, at 0930 hrs, in the vicinity of BT117114, found base camp with 4 shelters with tunnels; 8'X4'. Two were in good condition, one was burned out by artillery and one was being built. Found 2 casings of 155mm rounds along with tools (may be a booby trap factory). Also found radio wire, an illegible note and a PRC 25 battery. All was destroyed. Signs of activity in the area indicated that the Element may still be in the area.</p> <p>196th Bde, PFC Delrio, C/3-21, at 1610 hrs, in the vicinity of BT195118, while securing LZ for resupply, received 2 rounds of M-79 fire. Mission aborted. No casualties reported.</p>	BT194115
